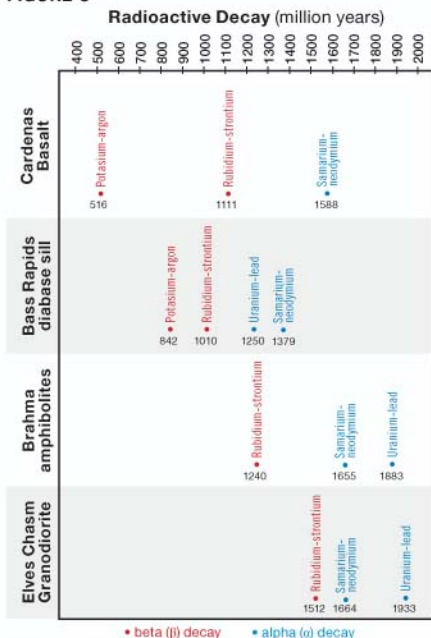


# PATTERNS IN THE RADIOMETRIC AGES

Just because radiometric “ages” sometimes conflict, we don’t have to toss out the measurements themselves. The two graphs below show that these measurements follow very clear patterns. While we reject the dates of “millions of years,” the measurements give us relative ages of rock layers (showing the order they were formed—during Creation Week, the Flood, etc.).
