Paper or Cardstock  
Crayons, Markers, or  
Colored Pencils  
Printer  
Scissors  
Glue  
Contact paper  
Ribbon or String

## Instructions:

1. Print this page in color on paper or cardstock.
2. Cut the bookmark out along the outside dotted lines and fold it in half along the center line.
3. Glue the two sides together so it stays folded.
4. Put a piece of cardboard in the center of the paper before gluing it for a sturdier bookmark.
5. Cover with clear contact paper or have it laminated at an office supply store so it lasts longer.
6. Poke a hole in the top of the bookmark and tie a ribbon, string, etc. through as a tassel.

Steps 4, 5, and 6 are optional.
